Injury to the Participants arm from bow string	Participants	Arm braces to be worn by Active Participants at all times. Correct shooting technique to be given by Instructor and implemented by Participants	Low	Low	None
Arrows Rebounding	All	Minimum shooting distance marked out. All none-active Participants to stay within the marked safety area at all times. Appropriate footwear to be worn.	Low	Low	None
Behaviour of Participants	All	If inappropriate behaviour from Participants. The Instructor will abandon the activity due to safety.	Low	Low	None
Removal of arrows from target.	Active participants	Arrows can only be removed, by Participants, at the Instructors guidance.	Low	Low	None

Facial Injuries in particular eye injuries caused by splinters from worn or damaged equipment or misuse of equipment.	Active Participants	Regular safety checks and maintenance of equipment. Clear instructions of how to handle equipment correctly. Instructor awareness and vigilance.	Low	Low	None
Overshoots	All	The target is screened from behind by substantial netting which will catch most of any overshoot arrows. The Fields to the rear and either side are the property of the campsite, which are no go areas. Also, clear warning signs are placed around the activity area.	Low	Low	None
Walking into arrows that fell short of the target	Active Participants	Participants retrieving arrows are instructed to use the clearly defined path to the target retrieving any arrows, that may have fallen short, working from the target to the shooting line.	Low	Low	None
Environmental Factors	All	Instructor to be aware of the weather conditions and all activities to be cancelled/postponed if weather conditions are deemed to endanger the safety of Participants. i.e., heavy rain, strong wind, lightning, etc.	Medium	Low	Monitor
Covid 19	All	All government And Scout Association Guidelines to be followed at all Times All Equipment to be cleaned and Sanitised after use.	High	Medium	Monitor
